### Set up of GREENUS framework

#### OUTPUTS

- Stakeholders List

Each University will elaborate a stakeholders list including local institutional, academic, industrial, and social contacts of actors involved in waste management and recycling in Vietnam and Myanmar (at least 25 contacts for each University). European partners will create a European stakeholders list including European associations and institutions involved in waste management, which will be informed about the project results and invited to share information.

Target groups: teaching staff, external stakeholders

- Stakeholders Roundtables

After the Kick-off-Meeting, each University will organize a stakeholder roundtable, inviting representative from Academia, Ministry, Industry, students, and local communities that will work together to define the matrix collecting needs and strategies in the beneficiary Countries.

- Matrix on local strategies

After the roundtable (one in each beneficiary University), a total of five matrixes will be created to summarize needs (at university, national, and regional level) and associate identified strategies. These documents will be used as a reference for the elaboration of the detailed didactic materials of the GREENUS courses.

### ○ Sapienza Staff Week

The meeting is organized by the International Office – Non-EU Mobility Sector. The work programme includes sessions in which Sapienza will present its activities, comparison of working experiences with other universities, and the exchange of best practices.
