### Building the courses

#### OUTPUTS

- Accredited/approved GREENUS courses

6 courses will be accredited and delivered at each beneficiary university for three semesters. At least 15 students per university will attend the courses each semester (estimate number of total students is 225).

Target groups: teaching staff

- Didactic materials

Teaching materials of each new course composing the didactic offer will be prepared. These will include slides, bibliography, exercises and tests, lectures, and project work items. European contribution will consist of operational approach beside up-to-date contents. A basket approach (such as Dropbox) will be used, gathering all available materials to benefit all participants.

Target groups: teaching staff, trainees, technical staff

- Didactic Laboratories

A didactic laboratory will be equipped and opened for students in each beneficiary University. The equipment will correspond to the local needs following the findings of WP1 and in coherence with the didactic plan. A detailed list of necessary equipment will be defined for each beneficiary University in WP1 and a tender will be opened for purchasing and installation in WP3. Equipment will be installed before the start of the courses and used during their delivery.

Target groups: teaching staff, students, trainees, technical staff

- Scientific Symposium

A two-day symposium to transfer knowledge will be organized in parallel sessions, one for each course, attended by the professors in charge of the delivery of the new modules at the beneficiary University. Participants will be trained on the main contents and will receive a Certificate of Participation.

Target groups: teaching staff, technical staff

- Handbook of Scientific Symposium

After the scientific workshop, a handbook will be elaborated describing the methodology applied for the elaboration of the courses, the courses content, the suggested exercises and reporting also bibliography and references used.

Target groups: teaching staff

- Letter of Commitment

A commitment letter for joint use of Laboratories will be signed by the Legal Representative of each University with the intent of sharing facilities and allow technical cooperation among universities in the same Country and abroad.
