OUTPUTS

- University-to-people online courses

Two short online courses will be elaborated for the dissemination to public and schools with general information about the importance of waste management and the consequence of incorrect behaviour and weak recycling policies for the environment. The videos will be done with the participation of all the partners who will explain the project goals, the European policies, waste management concept, the importance and ways of recycling, green economy, etc. (according to Course n.1). The aim of the videos is to spread important information about waste management, inform people and influence their behaviour in professional and domestic environments, encouraging them to adopt correct waste recycling behaviours.

Target groups: teaching staff, students, trainees, administrative staff, technical staff, librarians, other

- PhD students' mobility

A 1-month technical visit training in Europe will be organized for 5 PhD students. They will be invited to attend lectures and technical visits in one European University. PhD students will be involved in the project from the beginning in order to identify common research field with European partners and comply with preparatory activities for their stay in Europe (identification of the topic and proposed articles, etc). PhD students will be asked to show the results of their stay in Europe during the final conferences.

Target groups: students

- Webinar for local authorities

A webinar will be organized to share information and European best practices with Asian local authorities, on the implementation of correct waste management procedures and frameworks. The video will be published on the website and disseminated among other local authorities in different municipalities. Official language will be English but subtitles in local language will be created.

Target groups: external stakeholders

- Workshop for local companies

One workshop will be organized at each university, involving European and local companies to share information about correct and innovative waste management and financial opportunities coming from waste treatment and recycling.
